## Site Waste Management Plans

SWMPs are a regulatory requirement aimed at effectively managing and reducing the amount of waste produced by construction projects. Enzygo's team are trained in the CL:AIRE Definition of Waste: Development of an Industry Code of Practice so that they can provide advice on the minimisation and management of waste on brownfield and greenfield developments.
